Dream Employer 2020 competition terms

- 1. The competition is organized by Turundusproff OÜ.
- 2. Applications for the competition can be submitted until the **30th of November 2019**.
- 3. Applications can be submitted in three different categories (public sector, business sector and nonprofit sector).
- 4. The jury will choose three best organisations from the business sector, one best from the public sector and one best from the nonprofit sector.
- 5. Evaluating the applications the jury will take into concideration five criterias:
 - Clear and focused positioning of employer branding.
 - The organisations inner and outter identity's similarity.
 - Does the organisations actions support the positioning of employer branding?
 - Does the way the organisation brings it's planned actions to life supports it's positioning of employer branding?
- 6. From the finalists the jury will choose one main winner. The winners will be announced at the Dream Employer: 100 ideas conference on 29th of January 2020.
- 7. The competition and the Dream Employer survey's (leaders, current and potential employees vision of the organisation) participation fee is 699€ + VAT which includes participation in the competition, a workshop for the results and one pass to the Dream Employer: 100 ideas conference. All nonprofit organisations can compete free of charge.
- 8. All the organisations participating in the competition give impendent consent to use the information recieved from the competition without previous concert (examples at the conference, trainings and articles).
